Outing to Goslar on 9th April – Exhibition „Facing Britain“ at Mönchehaus Museum Goslar

How do the British see their country? The exhibition „Facing Britain“ painted a picture of the United Kingdom from the perspective of 44 British photographers – a picture with no clichés and motifs shown by the mass media. Featuring around 250 works from 1963–2020, it presented an interesting view of British documentary photography. The time period covered the UK’s membership of the EU and its predecessor as well as Brexit.

The photographers aimed their cameras at people’s everyday lives, their habits, their surroundings, their pleasures and moments of relaxation; but they also depicted social conflicts and political unrest. The pictures documented the decline of the Midlands, a region once dominated by coal mines and the steel industry, as well as the Thatcher era with the Falklands War and the current divisive upheaval that is Brexit. Questions about gender and migration are reflected particularly strongly in the pictures taken by the younger photographers.



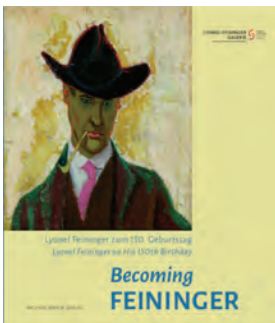

The world famous, Banksy is the Bristol-born and still anonymous graffiti artist and painter known for



challenging the boundaries of the art market and whose work has been causing a stir for many years. The Success Show „The Mystery of Banksy-A Genius Mind“ makes this art icon a topic!

This unprecedented presentation with more than 150 works by the celebrated street art superstar.

Graffiti, photographs, sculptures, video installations and prints on various materials such as canvas, fabric, aluminium, Forex and Plexiglas were reproduced and brought together especially for this special show. „The Mystery of Banksy-A Genius Mind“ gives the visitor a comprehensive overview and insight into the entire work of the genius and exceptional artist in an elaborate and unique setting. In line with Banksy's motto „Copyright is for losers ©TM“, this homage and the works shown there are not authorized by the artist due to his anonymous status. More outings are being planned so keep your eyes and ears open.
